

Memorandum of Understanding (MOU)

Global Star Edu will provide guidance and support to students of Vijaya College in obtaining financial aid for their education abroad. This may include assistance with scholarship applications, financial planning, and accessing funding sources.

Exchange Programs:

Both parties may explore opportunities for student exchange programs between Vijaya College and partner institutions of Global Star Edu. This will enhance cultural exchange and provide valuable learning experiences for students.



Collaborative Events:

Vijaya College and Global Star Edu may jointly organize seminars, workshops, and informational sessions to educate students about opportunities for overseas education and career development.

Duration:

This MOU shall be effective from the date of signing and shall remain in force for a period of one year from the effective date.

Termination:

Either party may terminate this MOU by providing written notice to the other party at least 90 days prior to the intended date of termination. Termination shall not affect any ongoing obligations or commitments of the parties.

Amendments:

Any amendments or modifications to this MOU shall be made in writing and duly signed by authorized representatives of both parties.

Governing Law:

This MOU shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of [Jurisdiction].

1. WHEREAS:

- I. 2. PREAMBLE

To impart industry relevant skills, VITW has collaborated with various industries and setup Centers of Excellence (CoE) to carry out training and to give a real-time hands-on experience. The Institute focuses on holistic development of students by adopting the most innovative and creative dimension to impart quality education and employability skills.
- 2.3 IBSC & VITW believes that collaboration and co-operation between themselves will promote more effective use of each of their resources and provide each of them with enhanced opportunities.
- 2.4 The Parties intended to cooperate and focus their efforts on cooperation within area of Skill Based Training, Education and Research.
- 2.5 The Parties hereby express their willingness to combine their resources for skill development in medical technology and related sectors, and work towards promoting the growth of the sector by creating necessary eco-system for the said purpose.

3. SCOPE OF MoU


EMPLOYER FEEDBACK:
