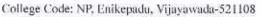


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STRATEGIC PLAN: 2024-2029

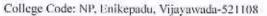
 National Recognition: Achieving accreditation for all eligible programs, solidifying the institute reputation for excellence.

Short-Term Plan (2019-2024):

P5: Develop a Centre for Global Engagement to facilitate faculty and student exchange programs, joint research projects, and international internships with global collaborations.
